



## Terms of Use

- A. **Restrictions.** End-User may not: (i) copy the Software, except that End-User may make necessary copies for backup and archival purposes only, (ii) use the Software in any manner that exceeds the Permissions specified in Exhibit A, (iii) use the Software in a manner that is contrary to applicable law or in violation of any third party rights of privacy, (iv) assign, sublicense, rent, lease, sell, or transfer the Software to any third-party (v) alter or permit a third party to alter any part of the Software, (vi) write or develop any derivative software or any other software program based upon the Software, (vii) use the Software to provide processing services to third parties, or otherwise use the Software on a "service bureau" basis, or (viii) disassemble, decompile, reverse engineer or otherwise attempt to derive the source code of the Software.
- B. **Multiplexing or pooling, automation.** It is strictly forbidden to use any technical, direct or indirect means (sometimes called multiplexing or pooling) as well as any action allowing to reduce the number of Licensed Users required by an application. You may not use the Software in an automated, unattended, non-interactive server application or component where: (i) multiple user requests from different users are queued for processing; or (ii) multiple requests from one user are queued for processing but acting against content created or edited by other users.
- C. **Software IP Ownership.** All title and Intellectual Property Rights in and to the Software (and the constituent elements thereof, including but not limited to any images, photographs, animations, video, audio, music, text and "applets" incorporated into the Software) are owned by LASCOM or its suppliers, excluding any End-User Data.
- D. **Reports and Output.** End-User shall own any physical or electronic reports, documents, or other output produced in connection with the use of the Software or other services by End-User.
